

Ashtabula County 4-H Hall of Fame Award

The Ashtabula County 4-H Committee is looking for 4-H Volunteers who go above and beyond in their position of a 4-H Volunteer. The committee is looking for 4-H volunteers who have excelled in the program in one or multiple ways for 10 or more years. The application should focus on the volunteer's whole 4-H experience- not just specific to one year.

GUIDELINES:

- The nominee is required to have 10 or more years of service.
- The application is due to OSU Extension by **4:30pm on September 15** and no late applications will be accepted.
- This application must be completed by a 4-H Club Advisor, Species or Committee Chairs, Key Leaders, Parents or 4-H member. Nominees are **not** limited to nominating someone from their own club or project area.
- Volunteers cannot nominate themselves. Applications can be typed or neatly printed and all parts of the application must be complete to be accepted.
- The winner will be announced at the Volunteer Appreciation Dinner in November.
- The inductee will also be nominated to represent Ashtabula County for the State 4-H Hall of Fame.
