

This provides the opportunity for the youth to present their work to others and builds confidence. Style Revue participation is required for those who wish to be considered for State Fair Competition and Best of Class Awards.

The Style Revue will be held at the *Expo Building* at the Fairgrounds at 7:00 p.m. July 15. Style Revue Narration Forms must be <u>TYPED</u> and are available by <u>clicking here.</u> Please type a Narration Form for your outfit <u>before</u> coming to judging. All Cloverbuds with sewing projects are invited to participate in Style Revue.

The presentation of General Projects, Sewing and Nutrition Best of Class Awards will be Tuesday, August 8 at the Stage at 7:00 p.m. in the Expo Building. Youth receiving a Best of Class Award will be mailed a letter.

Drug Use Notification Forms

Electronic Drug Use Notification Forms (DUNFs) will be used for all market and lactating dairy animals. The form will be posted July 1 and must be complete prior to Carcass Drop Off and Fair. Forms must be complete before arriving to Carcass Drop off July 26 and/or the gate on Sunday, August 6th and finalized by 10:00 p.m.

OHIO STATE FAIR JUNIOR HORSE SHOW ENTRIES

A list of PAS show dates is available online at horse.osu.edu on the 'PAS Qualifying Shows' tab.

PAS shows must use the 2023 PAS patterns that are available online at horse.osu.edu.

Ashtabula County will host a local PAS Show June 10 at 10:00 a.m. More information to pre-register may be found by <u>clicking here</u>.

- Youth may only attend 2 single-judged PAS qualifying shows or 1 double-judged show.
- The Out-of-County PAS Approval Form is available online at horse.osu.edu. Youth who participate in out-of-county PAS shows must upload a completed Out-of-County PAS Approval Form after each show to their 4HOnline account. A step-by-step guide to entering/uploading required horse information to 4HOnline is available online at horse.osu.edu.
- Youth must qualify in at least 2 PAS classes to be eligible to attend the Ohio State Fair Junior Horse Show. Please note that dressage classes are separate from PAS classes.
- PAS qualifying scores/times and class restrictions are available online at horse.osu.edu.

Dressage (Classical & Western) Show Qualifying Information

- Youth may ride a maximum of 2 tests (classes) at the Ohio State Fair Junior Horse Show. For each test the exhibitor would like to ride at the Junior Horse Show, they must have earned at least one score of 60% or higher on that particular test from an approved judge during the current calendar year. More information regarding dressage classes at the Ohio State Fair Junior Horse Show is available online at https://doi.org/10.1007/journal.org/
- Dressage entries must be mailed directly to the Ohio 4-H Horse Program office by July 1, 2023 and include copies of the qualifying test score sheets.
- Online registration for the Ohio State Fair Junior Horse Show for 4-H and FFA exhibitors that have qualified at a PAS qualifying show will open June 1, 2023. Entries will close on July 1, 2023. Coggins tests are required again this year so exhibitors showing at the Junior Horse Show must have their horse's negative Coggins test (dated on or after January 1, 2023) uploaded to their 4-H online account by the entry deadline of July 1, 2023.
