



2024 CARCASS SHOW ENTRY FORM

[Entry forms](#) are due by **July 1. NO LATE ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED**

All exhibitors must complete a certified Quality Assurance training by June 1 of the current year.

In addition to exhibiting one market animal at the fair, members may also enter the carcass show with one steer (beef or dairy), lamb, swine, or goat project. An exhibitor may have only one animal in the MAC Carcass Show (program). Each exhibitor shall weigh in only ONE market project. No substitutions of animals may be made. Animals must be clean, sound and in good health at unloading. The exhibitor is expected to assist in unloading.

To drop off a carcass animal, youth must have filled out an online Drug Use Notification Form (DUNF).

If the cut list is not turned in on the day of the show, Carcass Animals will have standard cut and wrap. Champion Hogs, Goats and Lambs will have a standard cut. Beef and Dairy beef will be custom cut. All animals must be processed at Kempfs, animals are not permitted to be taken elsewhere for processing.

Any animal that meets the requirements for placement in the MAC sale, cannot be pulled from the sale.

All Junior Fair exhibitors are responsible for following the current Market Animal Guidelines.

Drop off times are as follows:

All animals – WEDNESDAY, JULY 24, 2024 4:00 - 7:00 P.M.

The top 5 animals of all species will be the only animals sold at the MAC Sale. In order to be eligible for Grand Champion or Reserve Grand Champion youth must complete Skillathon: carcass evaluation 60%; specie skill-a-thon 40%.
