Market Rabbit Showmanship will be conducted during the fair for a separate score using an ARBA showmanship score sheet (separate age classes). Each exhibitor should know the breed of their rabbit, its age, sex, variety, characteristics, faults and DQs, how much it is being fed, the brand, and protein percentage of the feed being provided to the rabbit.
