

4-H Grows True Leaders

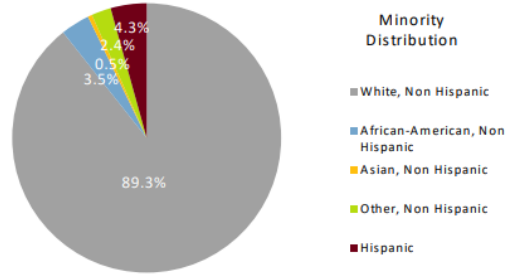
In 2025, it is the goal of 4-H nationwide to engage 10 Million Youth in 4-H programming. 4-H will reflect the population demographics, vulnerable populations, diverse needs and social conditions of the country.

This vision has the elements of inclusion, caring adults, serving at minimum **1 in 5 youth**, and the **volunteers and staff reflect the diversity of the population**.

For Ashtabula County in 2018, there were 18,016 Youth 4-H age (5-19) of which 5,273 youth of this age range were involved in 4-H programming in 2018. Therefore, with an increase of 2% from 2016, Ashtabula County is on target with **29.27%** of youth involved in 4-H programming.

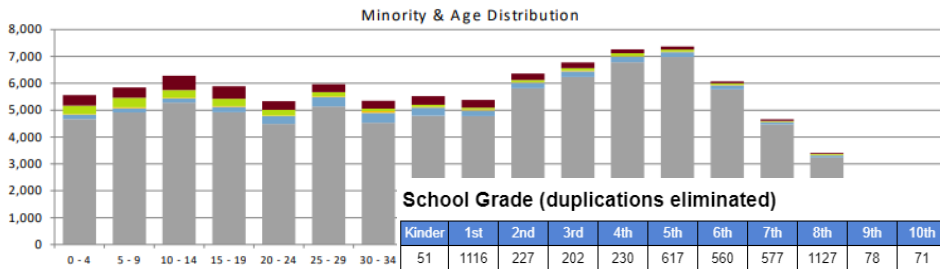
