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Job Descriptions

Class Tour Guide - As a guide, you will be helping a classroom through their Ag Day adventure. You will pick them up from their bus, help them stay on schedule and show them the different areas. Tour guides will meet at 8:00 a.m. to do a walk-through of the areas. After the walk through, you will have the opportunity to ask any questions, have some coffee and doughnuts or relax until your class arrives. You are able to request a specific classroom but this will be done on a first come basis.

Area Volunteer - We will have 3 areas with interactive educational sessions and displays you may choose to help with. Each area has a team leader who is coordinating the area's stations, displays and logistics. The team leader will contact you with information for each area including arrival times and expectations. Below is a short description of each area.

The Barnyard- This area allows youth to touch and feel different animals and learn exciting information about them.

Hands on Exploration- This area showcases a variety of agricultural products produced or used locally. They will get to see, touch and taste stuff.

Food and Environment- This area will show students the connection to what we eat, where it is processed and why it is important. It will also show the connection of why it is important for healthy soil and water.

Other- Please check this if you have talked to a committee member and have been asked for a specific job.

Afternoon Crew- This crew will come in the afternoon and be available to help load buses with their classroom goodies. Also help in the afternoon to help move tables and supplies back to the 4-H expo building and clean up.

Set up Crew- This crew will come to the fairgrounds Thursday May 11, 2017 and help set up tables, chairs, tents and sort supplies.
