Ever thought about growing shiitake mushrooms? Native to Japan, shiitake mushrooms (*Letinula edodes*) are becoming increasingly popular for their distinctive nutty flavor and high nutritional content. During this workshop, participants will learn the basics of growing shiitake mushrooms at home- including the best species of trees to use, log preparation, types of spawn, and inoculation. After a short classroom discussion, participants will drill and inoculate an oak log to take home. Participants are encouraged to bring a cordless drill and a 5/16" diameter bit if they have it, though several will be available to share.
